Kyle Clark is a 25-year-old artist & songwriter born in Hawaii and raised in Georgia. After winning the 101.5 Kicks Radio competition in Atlanta 2 years in row, Kyle's songs found their way to hit songwriter Jordan Schmidt (Blake Shelton/Tyler Hubbard) who offered him a publishing deal at Sony Music Publishing in 2019. Within the first year, Clark co-wrote his first RIAA certified Gold single (Lily Rose's "Villain") which led to more major label cuts with Jon Pardi, Mitchell Tenpenny, Restless Road, FILMORE & more. Facing the pandemic, Kyle focused his efforts on learning how to produce his own music, leaning into Schmidt and his roommate, producer Jacob Durrett (Morgan Wallen, Breland). His efforts paid off in early 2022, when a video featuring Clark's unreleased song "Hope It's Hot Out" went viral on Tiktok, HIHO was released May 23, 2023, quickly gaining 1 million streams in its first week and has since been streamed over 30 million times. Clark ended 2022 on tour with Matt Stell & Cooper Alan & has spent 2023 opening for Tyler Farr, Spencer Crandall, Cooper Alan & Tyler Braden. His new EP Hope It's Hot Out... Again was just released.




NELL MAYNARD
